This “Seller Server Training” is a state approved program and will cover the following topics:

- Identifying minors and VIPs
- Intervention to prevent a visibly intoxicated patron from driving
- How alcohol is ingested and metabolized by the body
- What alcoholism is and how alcohol affects the body
- False ID detection and carding policy
- The importance of good written policies
- The Liquor Liability Act

State Certificate Provided: Those that successfully complete the program will be registered with the Maine Department of Public Safety, Liquor Licensing and shall receive a certificate that is good for a period of three years.
