Mathews Wildlife Habitat	Take Route 202 out of Augusta, right on 17 past Kent's Hill School. Look for a wide opening in the stone wall on the south side of the road. There is a wooden post in the field with a stone plaque. Park along the shoulder of Route 17	Various	No marked trails, fields and woods	Walking, running, cross-country skiing
Sturtevant Farm Scenic Area	After passing the Fayette Store on route 17 head northwest for approximately 3 miles. Take Bamford Hill Rd. west 1.5 miles to Fayette Corners. Travel north on Baldwin Hill Road for about .3 miles	Unknown	22.5 acres, includes a band parking area	
Parker Pond Headland Preserve	From route 17 take Route 41 north 3.6 miles to the Chimney in West Mt. Vernon. Take Sandy river road 2.5 miles to Fellows Cove Road.	1.5 moderate trail	100-acre peninsula of land with 5,000 feet of rocky shoreline in Parker Pond. Has a boat launching site.
