Smithfield Plantation	Take Route 126 toward Litchfield. At the red blinking light near the Country Store take a left. After passing the fair grounds, turn right onto Libby road (near the fire station). A brown and white sign is about 2 miles down Libby Road on the left, with maps in the mailbox.	1 mile loop trail	103 acre nature area, which has been set aside as conservation land. two different trail loops, clearly marked.
